Captain Phil Carr was presented with the second annual Tim Stafford “Unsung Hero” Memorial Award. Captain Carr recently retired from the Oklahoma City Police Department. He has been a dedicated supporter of Special Olympics Oklahoma for many years through his involvement in Law Enforcement Torch Run activities. He will have the honor of carrying the Flame of Hope

into the Boone Pickens stadium during Summer Games Opening Ceremonies on May 12, 2004.

In 2002 at the LETR International Conference in Hawaii, Captain Carr was inducted into the Richard LaMunyon Torch Run Hall of Fame. This recognition honors people who have demonstrated a sustained and significant contribution to the Torch Run and Special Olympics at the local, national and international levels. Captain Carr is the first Oklahoma Law Enforcement officer to be inducted into the Hall of Fame. It is the most prestigious award given in the Torch Run Community.
