Trooper Steve Burrows of the Oklahoma Highway Patrol was chosen as the 2010 Tim Stafford "Unsung Hero" recipient. Burrows has been involved in Special Olympics and Law Enforcement Torch Run for 20 years. Upon graduation from the academy this recipient was told to report in running shoes to participate in the Torch Run. Having never heard of the Torch run and being an obedient young officer, he ran his first Torch Run in 1990 and has been running ever since. In 1999 he was nominated and took a place on the Oklahoma LETR Committee and in 2000 became a member of the summer games committee. He continues to serve on both committees' today. This nominee has participated in every summer games since 1990 in some capacity. Trooper Burrows has also organized several annual fundraising events such as a fishing tournament, 5K run and the Polar Plunge. Trooper Steve Burrows is a devoted officer, friend of all Special Olympic Athletes, and is truly and unsung hero.
